1. Suspension Hearing – Threadz Fashion LLC
Threadz Fashion LLC has accumulated 110 points, which results in a suspension hearing. Copies of the police reports, complaint and summons are attached. The suspension period for the points accumulated is three (3) to ten (10) days.
2. Class B Combination License application – Green Enterprises LLC
See attached. Currently, the establishment is not licensed. The application is for the remaining unissued regular Class B Combination License. If committee recommends granting the license, it should be contingent upon the amounts owing the city be paid.
3. Closing hours of Class “A” Fermented Malt Beverage and Intoxicating Liquor Licensed establishments
Wisconsin Act 97, effective December 21, 2011 changes the hours for selling fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquor from 12 midnight to 8:00 a.m. to 12 midnight to 6:00 a.m. A municipality may impose more restrictive hours. The hours in the current City Code does not allow sales from 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

The committee reviewed this issue at their January 11, 2012 meeting and the motion to change the hours died for a lack of a second.
4. Operator License application – Dalton J. Christie
See attached. The application has been denied by the Police Chief as Mr. Christie has two convictions for marijuana in the past five years and a pending case of possession of drug paraphernalia (That will be dismissed on 08/13/12).

Sierra was consuming alcohol in the bar.

COMPLAINT INFORMATION:

At 2:28a.m. on 10/29/11, dispatch gave out information that there was a fight in progress at Liquid, located at 214 W. Wisconsin Street. I was acting in capacity of field training officer for Officer Neumann and was operating our squad. We responded from approximately two blocks away.

Upon arrival at the location, there was a large group of people gathered outside the front door of the bar. As we exited the squad and began to try to figure out what was occurring, several subjects that were standing away from the front door of the bar pointed towards a van parked in the parking lot across the street, and stated that some subjects were going to that van that were involved. Officer Neumann went over to speak with those subjects. I saw farther down the street near Nona's Tailoring, that there was a white male subject yelling at several black female subjects. I went over there and separated the subjects in an effort to figure out what was happening.

Upon contacting the white male subject, who was later identified as Brian A. Ventrice, I found that he had a cut above his right eye that was bleeding lightly. Brian was very agitated and was screaming at the two black female subjects, who were leaning up against a vehicle. He was using loud profane language and calling them "bitches" several times. Eventually, to get Brian to calm down, I had to pull him away from those subjects to speak with him to find out what happened.

I spoke with Brian in an effort to ascertain how he received the injuries. Brian stated that he was in the bar and that one of the black females stole his wallet. Brian stated that he confronted the group of black females and eventually came outside where the whole group beat him up in the street. Brian initially stated that he was not certain who caused him the injuries but stated that the whole incident stemmed from somebody stealing his wallet within that group.

While I was speaking with Brian, it was evident that he was quite intoxicated, as his speech was slurred and he was unsteady on his feet. He also smelled strongly of intoxicants. Brian was not certain who had taken his wallet. Throughout my entire contact with Brian, he was very agitated and was yelling and screaming, even after me asking him to stop yelling several times, as he was continually being derogatory towards the black females that were involved in the incident.

I then spoke with the two black females that Brian had pointed to that were leaning against the vehicle in the bar. They were identified verbally as Natosha A. Dixon and Sierra S. Mathis. Natosha and Sierra advised me that they had not stolen Brian's wallet and that he had confronted them about the possibility of them stealing it and they told him that they had not. Natosha stated that Brian was highly agitated and was yelling and screaming at them and that he pushed her. Sierra advised me that after pushing Natosha, he slapped Sierra across the right side of her face.

Neither subject was certain how Brian had gotten the injuries.

While I was speaking with Natosha and Sierra, another female subject identified as Shalonda Dean came up and began speaking with us. Shalonda stated that she was not certain what had happened with regards to either the wallet or how Brian got injured.

I again spoke with Brian and he stated that both Natosha and Sierra had been involved in the fight where he had been jumped in the street by 6-7 black females. Besides Natosha and Sierra, Brian was not able to identify any of the other black females involved.

Officer Neumann had spoken with several other black females who were in a van in the parking lot across the street. They were identified as Shirley Stigler, Cleopatra Kinnemore, Jasmine Watkins and Natasha Collins. Officer Neumann advised me that those subjects advised that they had no idea what had occurred as they were in the bathroom when this whole incident went down. I did speak with them and they stuck with the story that none of them knew what happened.

I then spoke with the bouncers, Devon J. Wood, Ryan Weber and Todd Walther in regards to what had happened. I was advised by Devon that two black female subjects had started fighting inside the bar over an unknown matter. Devon stated that the bouncers escorted them outside and told them they were not welcome in the bar any longer. Devon stated that at one point, he was punched in the mouth by a black female subject, who he identified as wearing a red and white hoodie and having straight shoulder length hair. All the bouncers stated that once the group was escorted outside, they had no idea what had occurred with regards to Brian and the group of black females.

It appeared that after speaking with the group of females that Officer Neumann had spoken with, there was one black female who they referred to as Meeka that was no longer on scene, that may have been the primary aggressor and had started the whole incident. None of the females on scene matched the description given by Devon as to the female subject who was the primary aggressor inside the bar. Through some further follow up with some other people standing around, I was able to find out that Meeka would be Charmeka Johnson.

Officer Neumann had received a non-consent form from Brian in regards to what had occurred. While I was speaking further with Brian, the bouncers did locate Brian's wallet inside the bar under a bar stool near where the initial incident started. The wallet was returned to Brian and he then advised that he was still missing a cell phone and \$125. Brian had no idea who had taken the money or the phone.

After speaking with Officer Neumann and other officers who had been speaking with other subjects, I determined that based on statements based on Brian's actions, he would be cited with

City Ordinance Disorderly Conduct. Based on statements from Brian regarding Natosha Dixon and Sierra Mathis, I opted to cite them for Disorderly Conduct as well. I explained to all three subjects that they would be receiving citations via the mail for Disorderly Conduct.

I had spoken with Sierra and she gave a date of birth that would only make her 20 years old. I confirmed with her that she was 20 and asked her if she had been drinking inside the bar, which she stated that she had and that she may have had one drink. I requested Sierra to submit to a PBT, and which she did which was administered by Officer Neumann and he received a sample of 0.15%. Sierra was advised that she would be issued a citation for Underage Drinking.

I then returned to the bar after releasing all the other subjects from the scene. I again spoke with the bouncers and also the two bartenders, Olivia Hassler and Heather Killerlain. Through speaking with Olivia and Heather, it appeared that Brian had been at the bar with several black female subjects who they were not aware of their identities. They advised that Brian had a \$100 bill out and was ordering drinks, at which point the female subject they identified as Sierra took the \$100 bill out of his hand, in what appeared to be a playful manner. Olivia and Heather stated that Brian then appeared to over-react to the situation and that a fight then broke out, but they were unsure exactly who had started it. I was advised by all involved on behalf of the bar, that as soon as the fight broke out, they attempted to get everyone out of the door as fast as possible to avoid any more problems inside the bar.

I then addressed the issue of the underage person drinking in the bar. Todd stated that he had been working the door for the most part that night and that Devon and Ryan had only filled in when he went to the bathroom. Todd stated that as he recalled the female subject, identified as Sierra, coming into the bar and he stated that she had an identification card that identified her as being 21 years old. Todd was unable to recall what state that identification card was from. I advised them that I would not be issuing citations at this time for allowing minors to consume on the premises, but that I would be referring it to Officer Young for follow up via the point system.

The Disorderly Conduct citations and Underage Drinking will be mailed to their respective recipients.

When speaking with Brian, his injuries were very minor and he refused EMS. When speaking with Natosha and Sierra, neither of them had injuries and both refused any medical treatment.

ADDITIONAL CONTACTS

On Saturday, 10/29/11 at approximately 2:08a.m., I along with Officer Clark responded to Liquid for a report of a fight in progress.

Upon our arrival, I exited the squad car and was advised by a witness that there were three black females crossing the street, heading to their vehicle that were involved in the altercation. I went across the street and made contact with the female subjects while Officer Clark and other responding officers made contact with the other individuals involved.

I then made contact with Shirleyann Stigler, Natasha Collins and Cleopatra Kinnemore. I asked all three individuals to tell me what had happened today regarding the altercation. Shirleyann told me that she had not seen the altercation take place, but was told that a fight had occurred and that law enforcement was coming so it was time for them to leave. Both Natasha and Cleopatra told me that they were in the bathroom at the time of the altercation and had not seen anything. I asked all three why I would be told they were involved in the altercation, and all three had told me that they did not know why but they were not involved and did not know who was involved in the altercation.

I obtained identifications from all three females and told them to remain in their vehicle while I spoke with Officer Clark regarding this incident.

I then made contact with Officer Clark and briefed on him on what Natasha, Cleopatra and Shirleyann had told me regarding the incident. Officer Clark requested that I make contact with the male victim in this matter. I then made contact with Brian Ventrice. Brian was seated on a bench outside of Liquid. He appeared intoxicated and upset about the incident. Brian told me while he was in the bar, an unknown black female had taken his wallet out of his pocket, which he is now missing, along with his cell phone. Brian told me that he is currently missing a Blackberry phone, which he valued at approximately \$50. Brian provided the cell phone number to me for the phone, at which time one of the bouncers called the phone number in an effort to locate it inside the bar, which they were unable to do so. Another bouncer had come outside while I was speaking with Brian and handed me Brian's wallet, where I obtained his Wisconsin drivers license from. I then handed Brian his wallet and noted that there was no money inside the wallet. I asked Brian how much money he was missing, and he told me around \$125. The bouncer that had returned Brian's wallet to me had located it under a barstool near the bar.

While speaking with Brian, I did detect an odor of intoxicants coming from his person. I did note that he did have a scratch above his right eye from this incident. Brian did sign the non-consent form, stating that he did not give anyone permission to strike him or take any of his property.

On 10/29/11 at approximately 1:15p.m., dispatch requested me to respond to the Portage Police Department to meet a subject in the lobby that wanted to make a report in regards to an incident that had occurred at the Liquid Bar, which is located at 214 W. Wisconsin Street in the City of Portage.

The subject was invited into the police department and he identified himself by his Wisconsin photo identification as Brian A. Ventrice. He stated that his address is not current that is displayed on his drivers license and that he now lives with family on Carpenter Street in Baraboo. He just recently moved there and he did not have the house number, but would be sure to get it to me. He did give me his cell phone number, however that phone was lost during the incident at the Liquid Bar.

Brian was very upset when he came into the police department. He stated that he was attacked by several women last evening at the Liquid Bar and that he is going to receive a disorderly conduct ticket when he felt that he was a victim in this circumstance and only trying to defend himself and retrieve his property. He stated that the officers would not listen to him when he was trying to tell them what had happened, and he felt that he was being treated poorly when he had contact with law enforcement. He just did not feel that he was being treated fairly.

I asked Brian to explain to me what happened. Brian stated that he and his friend, David Feldman, went to the Liquid Bar on the late hours of 10/28/11 and the early morning hours of 10/29/11. He stated that when he entered the bar, he had \$228 in his wallet. \$200 was in \$100 bills and the \$20 was in miscellaneous bills. He stated that when he had designated one of the \$100 bills to pay his cell phone bill, the other was for incidentals including this evening out. He stated that at one point he had went up to the bar, David was not with him, and was holding his \$100 bill in his right hand while waiting to be waited on by the bartender. While standing there, a heavier set female black engaged in conversation with him. He stated that while he was talking to this woman, another woman, what he described as a skinny 5'7"(approx) female black came up on his right side and grabbed the \$100 bill out of his hand. He stated that he turned around and said "hey give that back" and she said to him that she wanted him to buy her a drink.

Brian told her to give him his money back. She did and he stated that he did buy the heavier set woman a drink, he thought. At the end of this exchange of money, he stated that she did give him a hug. That is when he feels that she removed his wallet from his right hand pocket, which would have been the side that she was standing on. He stated that he did not realize that the wallet had been missing right away and that when he did discover it missing, the bartender and/or bouncers were pushing both these females, plus 3-4 others out of the front door as they were being kicked out. stated that he pleaded with the bouncer not to kick them out because he was missing his wallet and he felt that they had it, and they told him no that the group had to go.

After the bartenders and/or bouncers got the females out, Brian stated that he followed out as well. He stated that they were almost to the other side of W. Wisconsin Street, the north side of the street, when he yelled to them, to give him back his wallet. He stated that as he was yelling, he walked over towards them and when he reached them, the female black that had taken his original \$100 punched him right in the face, what he thought had broken his nose. He stated that she continued to hit him as well as the other women, which was evident by the quantity and severity of injuries around his face and neck. Including the alleged broken nose at this time, he had several scratches, blackening around both of his eyes, his nose, his neck, his cheeks, part of his chest and he also had a small contusion behind his left ear. All of these injuries I did photograph, and I did attach to this report.

Brian stated that he never swung back at any of these women, but he did try to push them off of him and escape from them. They kept holding on to him, at which point both his coat was tore, which was a sweatshirt hoodie and they busted the zipper, which was zipped and broke when they tore it off of him. The coat damage was also photographed by me and he was able to retrieve his zipper pull, which was also photographed. The women pulled so hard on the hoodie, that they broke teeth out of the zipper.

I asked him what happened when the officers arrived, and he stated that he did not get to say much and that he was dealing with a very young officer. Brian stated that he was frustrated and told the officer to please look at his injuries, as he was in a lot of pain. As Brian was talking to me now, he stated that he was still in a lot of pain. He stated that he was told by an older officer that he was going to receive a disorderly conduct ticket for his involvement. He stated that he was very upset about this. Brian stated that he was just trying to get his wallet back, he told the officer and get them to get off of me. Brian was being continually interviewed by the officer when one of the bouncers/bartenders came out of the Liquid Bar and handed him his wallet, which they found on the floor with the only money that was remaining inside, was now missing. Brian was also missing his cell phone, which would have been in the pocket of his hoodie, that was not located.

I asked Brian if he would give a written statement of the information that he had passed on to me. I agreed to write the statement for him as he told it. After he told me what he wanted to say, I had Brian read each page and then sign the bottom. This was witnessed by me as well. While Brian was completing the statement information, I did call the owner of the Liquid Bar, Jake Stoltey, who in returned called me back after leaving a message. I asked Jake if a cell phone had been found in the bar, and he stated that it had not. I thanked him for his time.

Brian did not want to go to the hospital, because he stated that he doesn't have insurance for

almost 30 more days at his job and that he also has a medical bill currently pending. I told him that urgent care would be available to him, which would be at a lesser cost. He stated that he was going to go to Divine Savior Healthcare then as he was in a lot of pain in his nose. I had Brian sign the medical release information for the District Attorney's Office and he returned to the police department with a printout completed by the hospital of his treatment for the day. The X-rays that were taken were also going to be sent to a specialist for reading and review.

I told Brian that the officers were not interested in taking care of the situation, that would not be the case at all, but that if they were dealing with six individuals minimum in this call, it is hard at that time of night to sort through everything that happened and get all the information documented appropriately. I stated that he was right in coming in today and providing this information to us so that the investigation can continue.

Attached to this report, are pictures of Brian Ventrice, his four page statement, his discharge paper from Divine Savior Healthcare and the original medical records release information.

FOLLOW UP INTERVIEWS - CHARGES

I, Det Dan Pionke, was requested to follow up on this Battery and Disorderly Conduct complaint. I was advised officers originally had written ordinance tickets but had not yet served them. I was advised the suspect and victim, Brian Ventrice, had come in on a different date and had more severe injuries than originally reported. Due to the seriousness of these injuries, it was requested the ordinance citations not be mailed out and this report would be sent to the District Attorney's Office for review of possible charges.

CHARGES:

BRIAN A. VENTRICE is being referred to the District Attorney's Office for a charge of DISORDERLY CONDUCT, Violation of Statute 947.01.

NATOSHA A. DIXON is being referred to the District Attorney's Office for a charge of DISORDERLY CONDUCT, Violation of Statute 947.01, and BATTERY, Violation of Statute 940.19.

SIERRA S. MATHIS is being referred to the District Attorney's Office for a charge of DISORDERLY CONDUCT, Violation of Statute 947.01.

INTERVIEW WITH SIERRA S. MATHIS:

On 11/02/11, I interviewed Sierra Mathis at the Portage Police Department. Sierra had contacted me regarding this investigation as she applied for residency at the Howard Woods Apartments and was denied due to this fight. She stated she wanted to clear up the incident so she could apply and be accepted at the apartment.

I asked Sierra what occurred that night. Sierra informed me she was extremely intoxicated and she was intoxicated before she arrived at the bar and she didn't recall hardly anything that happened that night. Sierra stated this was the first time she was in Portage and she was not familiar with the other black females who were there besides the people in her family. She advised me the subjects at the bar with her was her sister, Natasha Collins, Jalissa Simons, her step-mother Natosha Dixon, a male subject by the name of Cleo, her cousin Shirleyann, and another cousin by the name of Shalonda.

I went into detail regarding this incident. Sierra again claimed at the time she was intoxicated and didn't recall what happened. I advised Sierra that since this investigation is open, I cannot

recommend dismissal of any of the charges or find out who struck the victim, Brian Ventrice, causing injury until this investigation is complete. I advised Sierra that with her cooperation, this investigation could be completed much sooner. I requested she find out who struck Brian Ventrice and to see if anyone had located his cell phone.

After advising Sierra of this, she did state she now recalled additional details regarding the incident. Sierra stated she remembered her cousin, Shirleyann, coming outside and advising Sierra that she went through a male subject's coat pocket while everyone was getting kicked out of the bar. She stated she couldn't find anything in the coat pockets so she threw it back on the ground. Sierra also recalled when they were outside the bar, she believed Brian Ventrice hit her step-mother, Natosha Dixon, and it was possible her step-mother then struck him back. She stated her memory was clouded due to her intoxicated state but she believed this was the person who struck Brian Ventrice. She stated she didn't recall any other subjects who would have struck him. I advised Sierra to contact me in the future if she had any additional information regarding the cell phone or who else may be involved in this battery complaint.

PHONE CONTACT WITH SHIRLEYANN STIGLER:

On 11/03/11, I received a phone call from Shirleyann Stigler. Shirley stated she heard her name was being mention for stealing the subject's cell phone and money. She stated she would never steal from anyone. She stated she was in the bar when the altercation occurred but the altercation occurred somewhere over where she had placed her shoes and she walked to the other side of the bar when the altercation occurred. She advised when all the subjects were getting kicked out of the bar, including her family, she walked over to get her shoes and then walked outside. She stated she never took anyone's money or cell phone and she wanted to clear this up because she heard her name was mentioned. She stated she is currently in the Milwaukee area but would be coming to Portage within the next week and she would come in and fill out a statement as to what occurred that evening. She stated she did see a scuffle outside but had no idea who was involved in the altercation but she was not involved.

PHONE CONTACT WITH NATOSHA DIXON:

On 11/04/11, I, Det. Dan Pionke, contacted Natosha Dixon. I called her at 1:33 p.m. from the dispatch recorded phone. I spoke with Natosha about the altercation.

Natosha stated she reported what happened to law enforcement at the time. I asked if she was struck by Brian Ventrice as stated by Sierra Mathis. Natosha stated she was and he came out swinging at her after he accused them of stealing money and a cell phone. I asked Natosha if she retaliated and struck back. She initially stated she did not. I asked if the cameras would show differently and if it was possible she did strike him. She then stated it was possible that she did strike

Brian Ventrice. I asked how many times she hit him. She stated she thought it would have only been one time but everything happened so fast. I asked if anyone else struck Brian. Natosha stated she didn't know and if I had cameras, I should watch the cameras. Natosha stated she was just trying to get Brian off her. I asked how the fight was broken up. Natosha stated she had no idea. She thought it was when the police arrived and the male subject walked away.

I questioned Natosha again as to who would be a good witness to verify her story that she was struck first. She stated I should ask Sierra. I advised her that Sierra stated she was too intoxicated to recall the incident. Natosha then told me she didn't know and if I needed to find out, I should look at the cameras. Natosha was very standoffish and was not cooperating with this investigation.

It does appear that possibly both Brian Ventrice and Natosha Dixon did strike each other during this altercation. I asked Natosha if Brian struck her with a closed fist. She stated she didn't believe so as it did not hurt which made her believe it was with an open hand. I again tried to question Natosha regarding her striking Brian with an open or closed fist. She again mentioned I should look at the cameras.

OBSERVATION OF CELL PHONE:

I observed that Officer Johnson had recovered the cell phone from Shakita Redwood. I observed the phone was on when I received it. The picture on the phone is a young male white child with a fish. It was extremely apparent this did not belong to the group Shakita stated as her family are all black in color. Shakita claimed she thought it was a relatives phone. I believe one of the subjects in the group had stolen the cell phone and it was returned upon my request after advising Sierra to try to locate the phone.





Survey of Municipalities regarding late fees charged for alcohol license applications

- We do not charge an extra fee if they are late they just need to decide if they can afford to shut their doors until the Council can approve their license renewal or if wish to ask for a special meeting. Special meeting fees are now \$1250 (there are three meetings involved \$250 for our committee meeting, \$500 for Committee of the Whole and \$500 for Council).
- We charge \$25 for late apps and the non-refundable special meeting fee is \$500 per license.
- If we need to have a special meeting we charge for the entire cost of the meeting. My time to publish, post, get it ready, etc and the pay for the board members.
- We charge \$150 for the special meeting that's it.
- We do not schedule a special meeting when they miss the correct meeting, we do charge them for the republishing of the hearing for their license, and we demand they be shut down or only sell soda until their license is renewed.
- Charges \$1,000 as a late fee for turning in the applications late.
- Charges \$25. Would NOT hold a special meeting.
- \$10.00 late fee is charged after June 30th. Special meetings for licenses are not permitted per city resolution.
- We don't charge a late fee, but if they have to have a special meeting to have their license approved, they have to pay for that--\$125, maybe less if fewer trustees are present.
- A \$10.00 late fee surcharge for separate legal notice publication fee. Plus special meeting fee is charged at \$100.00 base fee plus per diem rate per member present.
- We do not have any special meetings, if they submit late, it waits until the next meeting.

- We tell the applicants that if they are late in getting in renewals, they will have to pay for a Special VB Meeting at a cost of \$450.
- We charge \$350.00 if a special meeting needs to be called because they are late.
- We do not charge any late filing fees or fees for a special meeting.
- The owners who submit their applications on time share the cost of the publication, so I make anyone who submits the application late pay their publication cost alone. Also, if they need us to schedule an extra meeting they would pay the cost of that - \$250.
- We don't charge a late fee, but we do charge \$200 for a special meeting.
- Our late fee is \$25 or 20% of the license fee, whichever is greater. Therefore, the late fee on an alcohol license is \$120 and we will NOT hold a special meeting. They will have to close down until the next regularly scheduled council meeting.
- If they require a special meeting, I charge them the entire cost of the special meeting.
- \$25 for Alcohol Licenses plus the publication fee; \$5 per machine for vending machines; We have an accelerated fee for cigarettes
