

NOTICE OF CHANGE TO ABSENTEE BALLOT RETURN PROCEDURES

Due to a recent ruling by the Waukesha County Circuit Court, the following changes on how to return an absentee ballot are in effect for the April 5, 2022 Spring Election.

- A voter may no longer return a ballot by using the drop box. Any ballot placed in the drop box will not be counted, in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 6.84(2).
- A voter may only return an absentee ballot by mail or by delivering in person to the Municipal Clerk, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 6.87(4)(b)1.

No ballot will be accepted that is delivered on behalf of another person, unless specifically authorized by law to deliver a ballot on behalf of a third party.
